Your brain is like a muscle. It needs exercise.

If you want to get better you must work your memory, attention, logic, creativity and more. No Al can do that for you. Your mind will grow stronger if you really revise. You must learn in many different ways, and each person will learn at their own speed. Learning also means occasionally making mistakes along the way and then fixing them. There's satisfaction in accomplishing things yourself.

Al consumes!

Each time we use AI (even for a simple prompt), it activates very powerful computers. which we call servers - sometimes on the other side of the world in large data centers. And it consumes a lot of energy and water. So, we must think carefully before using Al if a simple dictionary, search engine or trusted adult doesn't already have the answer.

Warning: Al can sometimes be wrong.

What it tells you can seem super intelligent ... but sometimes, it's wrong! You should ask yourself guestions and check the information against other sources. Be careful for mistakes and sometimes even hallucinations (invented answers) because they can lead to bad decisions.



RFMINDFR

Al can be helpful ... but you need to learn and not it. Your brain will always be your biggest help, and Al uses a lot of energy. So use it intelligently.

Be curious and believe in yourself: you have everything you need to succeed.
